THEME: Armor of God

Ephesians 6:11 – 12 “Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly place” (NKJ).



Dear Brothers and Sisters,
the love of God to us is demonstrated by the gift of Christ and the ultimate power bestowed upon us through our Lord Jesus Christ to overcome the world and to trample over serpents, scorpions and our enemies. God assures us of His everlasting divine protection, as we are in the spiritual battle. And Armor of God is the uniform of the church moving from victory to victory. As we prepare to celebrate Pentecost next Sunday, we are expectant of His glory and victory, the divine defense and power, the Love and Life of the Lord to be revealed in us and through us. We will remain in prayers in truth and spirit through fasting that begins at 9pm of 2nd June to 12pm 8th June 2019.

Modes of Fasting:

- ✓ **Regular Fast:** Only one meal a day. You are free to take fruit juice. No coffee/tea.
- ✓ **Partial Fast:** Remove favorite list of items from your meal e.g. coffee, chicken, bread, tea, fruits etc (If you choose Daniel fast, then eat vegetables only);

Very Important:

- ✓ People who are either **sick, pregnant, breastfeeding and on medication** are NOT expected to fast. ONLY SEEK to Encounter and Experience the Rise Lord.

<p>✓ Seek the face of the Lord to establish you serve HIM with power. <p>✓ Meditate on the true meaning of salvation, where you are in salvation, and ask God to strengthen your knowledge, understanding and living of true salvation</p>	<p>Exodus 15: 2 The Lord <i>is</i> my strength and song, And He has become my salvation; He <i>is</i> my God, and I will praise Him; My father’s God, and I will exalt Him.</p> <p>2 Samuel 22:3 The God of my strength, in whom I will trust; My shield and the horn of my salvation, My stronghold and my refuge; My Savior, You save me from violence.</p>
<p>✓ Resist, deny and refuse the works of sin, the devil and all their adversaries. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Read and mediate on the Word of God and prophetically declare that HIS word comes to pass in your life 	<p>Hebrews 4: 12 For the word of God <i>is</i> living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.</p> <p>Mathew 4: 1 – 10 Then Jesus was led up by the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil. And when He had fasted forty days and forty nights, afterward He was hungry. Now when the tempter came to Him, he said, “If You are the Son of God, command that these stones become bread.” But He answered and said, “It is</p>

	<p>written, 'Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God.' " Then the devil took Him up into the holy city, set Him on the pinnacle of the temple, and said to Him, "If You are the Son of God, throw Yourself down. For it is written: 'He shall give His angels charge over you,' and, 'In <i>their</i> hands they shall bear you up, Lest you dash your foot against a stone.' " Jesus said to him, "It is written again, 'You shall not tempt the LORD your God.' " Again, the devil took Him up on an exceedingly high mountain, and showed Him all the kingdoms of the world and their glory. And he said to Him, "All these things I will give You if You will fall down and worship me." Then Jesus said to him, "Away with you, Satan! For it is written, 'You shall worship the LORD your God, and Him only you shall serve.'</p>
<p>✓ Using the Word declare that No weapon formed against you will prosper; release the sword of the Lord to destroy all evil plans against you, your family and the body of Christ.</p>	<p>Isaiah 54:17 (NKJ) "No weapon formed against you shall prosper, And every tongue <i>which</i> rises against you in judgment You shall condemn. This <i>is</i> the heritage of the servants of the LORD, And their righteousness <i>is</i> from Me,"</p> <p>Psalms 91:7-16 (NKJ) A thousand may fall at your side, And ten thousand at your right hand; <i>But</i> it shall not come near you. Only with your eyes shall you look, And see the reward of the wicked. Because you have made the LORD, <i>who is</i> my refuge, <i>Even</i> the Most High, your dwelling place, No evil shall befall you, Nor shall any plague come near your dwelling; For He shall give His angels charge over you, To keep you in all your ways.
