**“Spirit-Led Living”**

“What does it mean to be led by the Holy Spirit?” (Gal 5:25).

*Living by the Spirit*

1. Gives life to every human being (Genesis 2:7; Psalm 104:29-30). Thus, all people are sons and daughters of God.
2. Convicts of sin (John 16:7-11). This is similar to or perhaps the same as the human conscience. The Spirit shows us our sin and convinces us it is wrong.
3. Guides us to truth and enables us to have faith in Jesus (John 14:6; 16:13-15; Ephesians 2:8)
4. Makes us spiritually alive in a renewed relationship with God (John 3:1-8, 16; 7:37-39; 20:19-23). That is, the Spirit makes us born again.
5. Gives power to resist sin and to live at peace (Romans 8:1-6, 9; Gal 5:16)
6. The Holy Spirit produces “fruit”, i.e., beautiful qualities in our life and is the source of divine qualities that believers can exhibit. (Galatians 5:22-23; 2 Peter 1:2-3)
7. Helps us pray (Rom 8:26-27; 1 Cor 14:2, 18; Eph 4:18)
8. Gifts and empowers us for Christian service (1 Cor. 12; Rom. 12:3-8; 15:18-19; Eph. 4:11-16)
9. Empowers us to fight evil (Ephesians 6:10-20, see esp. vv. 17-18 Sword of the Spirit, pray in the Spirit)
